RESOLUTION NO. 6-4-86-34

- WHEREAS, the Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Tribe of which the Tribal Council is the governing body, and
- WHEREAS, the Bad River Tribe has determined that it is essential that the Tribe maintain control over its own bingo and raffles and the receipts from these enterprises, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe believes that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to regulate the conduct of bingo and raffles by enacting an ordinance pursuant to Article VI Section 1(q) of the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe believes it is important to give the Tribal Court jurisdiction to hear any cases brought pursuant to this ordinance,
- NOW THEN BE IT RESOLVED that the Bad River Tribe hereby adopts and enacts the attached Bingo and Raffle Ordinance for the Bad River Tribe.
- AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ordinance is effective on this same date of adoption and that all other Ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

#### CERTIFICATION
